Course Description

MTS-07 is a blended course consisting of onsite and online academia studies. The primary instructional strategies used include self-directed learning, self-assessment, lecture, peer exchange and reflective practice. All students must complete 45 hours of instructional studies and 255/300 hours of supervised substance abuse counseling at an approved site. This course is a minimum of 6 months in length.

- Practice exams on a regular basis for preparation of desired Certification/Licensure exam.
